**EUROPEAN SUMMER SCHOOL IN EUROPEAN PROJECT
MANAGEMENT: ERASMUS PLUS, EPALE**

Introduction: Our Summer School, now in its fourth year, is an annual in-depth study of European planning activities. It is held over two days, so as to facilitate participation and maintain low costs both for members and other participants. We choose a peaceful location – an island of calm, surrounded by nature – away from phone lines, with only a wi-fi connection. Detached from outside distractions, we find ourselves deeply immersed in nature with time and space to reflect and deepen understanding. This also allows for greater time with the tutor, to clarify doubts and overcome any misgivings. The summer school will also include a workshop aimed at developing project proposals in anticipation of upcoming deadlines.

This year we have chosen **Erasmus Plus** (Erasmus+) and the **EPALE** platform (ePlatform for Adult Learning in Europe). Erasmus Plus is a programme open to all those involved in education – students, schools, adults and researchers – while EPALE is a multilingual open membership community; both are funded by the European Commission. The summer school will be held entirely in English. The teacher is Italian.

Objectives: Learn how to design and understand how to write a European project, and how to respond to an EU Erasmus+ invitation to tender; know the EPALE platform and use it to greatest effect across education projects targeted at adults.

EPALE

EPALE is a multilingual membership community open to teachers, trainers, academic researchers, policy makers and anyone else who plays a professional role in the adult learning sector across Europe. Funded by the European Commission, it aims to improve the quality of adult learning throughout Europe.

The EPALE community is organized around the sharing of content related to adult learning, including news, blog posts, resources, events and courses. Community members can communicate with other colleagues in the adult learning sector through the site forums and by adding comments to blog posts. They can also find projects, establish professional contacts and search the archives for partners. See <https://ec.europa.eu/epale/en/about>

Erasmus Plus

Erasmus Plus is the European Union Programme for Education, Training, Youth and Sports 2014–2020

The programme combines and integrates all the EU's financing schemes for education, training, youth and sport implemented up to 2013. It includes:

- the Lifelong Learning Programme (Comenius, Erasmus, Leonardo da Vinci, Grundtvig)
- Youth in Action
- the five international cooperation programmes (Erasmus Mundus, Tempus, Alfa, Edulink and the bilateral cooperation programme with industrialized countries). It also includes Jean Monnet Activities and, for the first time, support for sports.

The integrated programme allows people to gain an overview of the grant opportunities available. It aims to facilitate access and promote synergy between different sectors by removing the barriers between the various types of projects; and aims to attract new players from the
