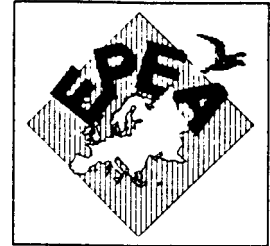

Procedures for Payment

Liaison Persons (and single members) are asked to follow **one of these options** when sending membership fees -
